JOINT BOARD/SENATE LIAISON COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

NAME: This Committee shall be called the Joint Board/Senate Liaison Committee.

STATUS: The Joint Board/Senate Liaison Committee is a committee of the Board of

Governors.

MANDATE: The purpose of the Committee is to serve as a means of jointly identifying

opportunities for collaborative action and problem-solving between the

Board of Governors and Senate on matters of common interest.

MEMBERSHIP: The membership of the committee shall be the following:

Ex officio (voting) Members

- Chair of the Board;
- Chair of Senate.

Appointed Members (voting)

- Two members of the Board of Governors;
- Two members elected by Senate.

Ex officio (non-voting) Members

- Vice-President Academic and Provost
- Vice-President Administration.

Resources

 There are no resources named for this committee. However, the Committee may invite members on an ad hoc basis to serve as resource persons.

Chairing of Joint Board/Senate Liaison Committee meetings will alternate between the Chair of the Board and the Chair of Senate.

MEETINGS: The Committee will meet at least twice annually.

QUORUM: A majority of the total voting membership shall constitute a quorum.

the Executive Committee of the Board, and to the Senate through the
